## James Murray Gosper

At its meeting on 26 May 1989 the Council accepted the resignation of Mr J.M. Gosper AM, OBE, BE, LGE, FIEAust, FAIB, FCIArb, FIArbA, FFB.

Murray Gosper, a civil engineer by profession, was very much involved in the formation of this Institute and in 1977 became the inaugural Chairman of the New South Wales Chapter, a position he held until 1979. Following that he served for a further period of three years on the Chapter Committee.

During those early years Murray gave unstintingly of his time and talents in the interests of the Institute. He was the author of several of the original Practice Notes published by the Institute for the guidance of practising arbitrators and he was always readily available to give advice to less experienced arbitrators who sought his help.

Apart from his involvement with the Institute of Arbitrators Australia, Murray Gosper rendered distinguished service to the profession of engineering as a whole and to the civil engineering construction industry in particular. He was for many years a Councillor of the Institution of Engineers Australia and he was the first Executive Director of the Australian Federation of Civil Engineering Contractors, now known as Australian Federation of Construction Contractors.

Murray Gosper was one of the group of dedicated people who set the high standards to which this Institute continues to aspire and to whom the present-day members owe a considerable debt of gratitude.
