This nitiative by the Senior Vice-President, Mr A.A. de Fina has been adopted by Council. The scheme has as its objective ascertaining as much information as possble and, following objective analysis, Council will plan the Institute's future direction be it in the areas of education and training, public relations, regiona developments, etc.

In the past there have been limited surveys from time to time principally focusin; upon the eastern seaboard cities of Sydney and Melbourne.
