WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ORDINANCE 1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Weights and Short title Measures Ordinance 1959.*

and citation.

- (2.) The Weights and Measures Ordinance 1929-1937† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Weights and Measures Ordinance 1929-1959.
- 2. Section three A of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—
- "3A. Subject to this Ordinance, the Regulations under the Application Weights and Measures Act, 1915-1956 of the State of New Regulations. South Wales, in force at the commencement of this section, shall, subject to such modifications, adaptations and exceptions as are prescribed, apply to the Territory.".

3. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-sections (2.) and (3.) and inserting in their stead &c. Appointment of Inspectors, &c. the following sub-section:—

"(2.) The Minister may authorize a person to exercise the powers and perform the functions of a Superintendent under the
