

PUBLIC SERVICE ORDINANCE (NO. 3) 1968

35

No. 14 of 1969

An Ordinance to amend the *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1965, as amended by the *Public Service Ordinance* 1968 and the *Public Service Ordinance* (No. 2) 1968

[Reserved 28 June, 1968]

[Assented to 12 June, 1969]*

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1968, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Service Ordinance* (No. 3) 1968. Short title

(2.) The *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1965, as amended by the *Public Service Ordinance* 1968 and the *Public Service Ordinance* (No. 2) 1968, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) Section 1 of the *Public Service Ordinance* (No. 2) 1968 is amended by omitting sub-section (4.).

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1968.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator in Council. Commencement

4. Section 24 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (c) of sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:— Appeal Board

- (i) an appeal by an officer of a Branch of the Department of the Administrator, an officer of the Branch elected as a representative by the members of that Branch; or
- (ii) an appeal by an officer of the Department of the Legislative Council, an officer of the Department of the Legislative Council elected by the members of that Department.”.
