AN ACT to amend the *Apprentices Act* 1942.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Apprentices Act* 1944. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Apprentices Act* 1942* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Subsection (2) of section twenty-one of the Principal Act is amended— Apprentices to attend classes, &c.

(a) by deleting the words “two of the first three years of”; and

(b) by deleting the words “the case may require” and substituting therefor the words “may be directed by the Commission”.
