AN ACT to amend the Apprentices Act 1942. [14 December, 1944.]

A.D. 1**944**

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Apprentices Act Short titl and citation.
- (2) The Apprentices Act 1942* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- **2** Subsection (2) of section twenty-one of the Principal Apprentices to attend classes, &c.
 - (a) by deleting the words "two of the first three years of"; and
 - (b) by deleting the words "the case may require" and substituting therefor the words "may be directed by the Commission".
