AN ACT to appropriate in the Years 1885 and A.D. 1885. 1886 certain Sums arising from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for certain Public [5 December, 1885.] Works.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, in the year 1885, for the several purposes mentioned in the Schedule (1.), and in the year 1886, for the several purposes mentioned in the Schedule (2.), any sum or sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money in the said Schedule (1.) and (2.) respectively specified.
- 2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums to Moneys payable such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such by Warrant of days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under Governor. his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the said Colony.

Credit to be given to the Treasurer in accounts. 3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
