

 $\mathbf{A}\mathbf{N}$ ACT to further amend "The Game A.D. 1903. Protection Act, 1895." [23 December, 1903].

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Game Protection Amendment Short title. Act, 1903."
- 2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Interpretation. 59 Vict. No. 26. Game Protection Act, 1895."
- 3 If any person buys, sells, or offers for sale any of the birds Penalty for buyenumerated in the Schedule (2.) of the said Act, every person shall ing or selling for every such bird so bought, sold, or offered for sale, incur a penalty birds mentioned in Schedule (2.) not exceeding Twenty Shillings.

Game Protection Amendment.

Kangaroo not to be protected on King Island.

4 The provisions of the said-Act, and every Amendment thereof, so far as they relate to Kangaroo, shall not apply to that portion of the State called King Island, situate in Bass Straits, for a term of Two years from the commencement of this Act.

Acts to be read together.

5 This Act and the said Act, and every Act amending the same, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
