To provide for the vesting in the Crown of certain land abutting the wharf on the Moyne River at Port Fairy.

WHEREAS the land which is delineated and shown hatched on the Preamble. plan in the Schedule is part of Atkinson's Crown Special Survey granted by the Crown in 1843 and in 1852 was conveyed to John Mills, Peter Nicholson and Robert Woodward on trust for a public wharf:

5 And whereas it is desirable that portion of that land be made the subject of a lease together with adjoining land of the Crown and that the remainder be retained for use as a public roadway:

And whereas it is expedient that for those purposes the land be vested in the Crown:

10 Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):

1. This Act may be cited as the Port Fairy Land Act 1983.

15. 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commencement. the Royal Assent.
