A BILL

to amend Part VI. of the *State Electricity Commission Act 1958* and for other purposes.

State Electricity Commission (Tree Clearance) Act 1985

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to require consent of certain persons to the making of a declaration of an area under Part VI. of the *State Electricity Commission Act 1958*.

Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on the 28th day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act.

3. In this Act, the *State Electricity Commission Act 1958* is called the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 65.

4. (1) After section 65 (3) of the Principal Act, insert:

“(3A) An Order shall not be made under sub-section (3) declaring an area that includes public land unless the person responsible for the management of the public land has consented in writing to the making of the Order.” 5

- (2) An Order made under section 65 (3) of the Principal Act before the commencement of this Act is revoked.
