A BILL

To amend Section 29E of the Second-hand Dealers Act 1958.

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Second-hand Dealers Short title. (Charitable Collectors) Act 1972.

(2) In this Act the Second-hand Dealers Act 1958 is called the Principal Act. Principal Act. Reprinted with

10 (3) This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Commenceproclamation of the Governor in Council published in the ment. *Government Gazette*.

- 2. The Principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—
 (a) For paragraph (e) of sub-section (1) of section 29E there
 - shall be substituted the following paragraph—
 - "(e) In respect of each collection the charity collector shall pay the recognized organization a sum calculated in the

prescribed

prescribed manner being a sum not less than 50 per centum or such lesser percentage as is determined under sub-section (2) of the proceeds of the collection.";

(b) At the end of section 29E there shall be inserted the 5 following sub-section :---

"(3) For the purposes of paragraph (e) of sub-section (1) the proceeds of the collection shall be—

- (a) where the charity collector collects the 10 articles—the total proceeds of the sale of the articles collected less the reasonable cost of collection; and
- (b) where the articles are collected for or on behalf of the charity collector by a 15 charity sub-collector—the total proceeds of the sale of the articles collected less the amount paid to the sub-collector."
